

CALL FOR PROPOSALS

Language Teaching and Learning Today (LTLT) is an international conference, aiming at exploring crucial issues of teaching and learning English language for the sustainable development of the community in the 21st century. The conference is annually organised by Faculty of Foreign Languages, Ho Chi Minh City University of Technology and Education. This year, LTLT 2019 includes a keynote speech, two featured talks, and several presentations on diversity and unity of language education in the globalised landscape. Invited speakers of the conference are Assoc. Prof. Dr. Garold Murray, Dr. Hafizoah Kassim, and Dr. Chinh Nguyen.

LTLT 2019 is calling for proposals of four kinds, namely **Research Paper, Workshop, Panel Discussion, and Poster Presentation**. Proposals are expected, but not limited, to address the issues of autonomy and motivation of language learners in a broad context of inter-connectivity and inter-relatedness from different parts of the world. Each proposal can consider particular focuses relevant to any of the sub-themes as listed below.

1. Learner autonomy, individual learning, and collaborative learning
2. Learning motivation, success, and preferences
3. Language development and learning opportunities
4. Learning attitudes and identity
5. Learning behaviors in inter-independent learning space
6. Language and culture in learning communities
7. Material presentation and development in globalised context
8. Assessment and learning achievement in constructivism
9. Teaching practices in the blended learning mode
10. English medium instructions for knowledge acquisition and development
11. Technology enhanced language teaching and learning
12. Content and language integrated learning
13. Professional development practices for language teachers
14. Community-based approach for sustainable development

All proposals must be written in English language and should be submitted at <https://liltcon.org> from now to March 3rd 2019. All relevant instructions are provided to you once you register as a **Presenter** in the registration process. If you need these guidelines in advance for the preparation of your proposals, please be advised of the following details.

Proposal Type	This indicates the nature of the proposal, which should be Research Paper, Workshop, Panel Discussion, or Poster Presentation. Each Research Paper or Workshop must be delivered within 30 minutes, including the Q and A section with the audience. Each Panel Discussion is done in 60 minutes. The Poster Presentation must be prepared in A0 paper size.
Title	Each title should not be longer than 15 words for the sake of formatting. Titles of more than 15 words can be placed in the body of the abstract.
Abstract	Each abstract should be between 200 and 500 words and must be placed directly into the abstract box. File attachment is not allowed.
Keywords	Biographies are required for both main authors and co-authors. Each biography should be between 150 and 250 words and must be placed directly into the biography box. Attachment is not allowed.
Biography	Biographies are required for both main authors and co-authors. Each biography should be between 150 and 250 words and must be placed directly into the biography box. Attachment is not allowed.
Full-text Paper	This section only comes up if your proposal is a Research Paper. The full-text version of the paper needs to be prepared in a word document, either in .doc or .docx, and submitted by March 31st 2019. Each paper must be between 2500 and 7000 words long, excluding the references and appendices. All papers must strictly follow the guidelines of APA 6th.

After submitting a proposal, the authors should expect to receive a confirmation of the submission within 3 working days via email. Authors are advised to check the spam mail folder of their mailboxes or contact us if they do not receive any confirmation from us. All abstracts will be reviewed, and authors will be notified of acceptance by 10th March 2019. All accepted proposal abstracts and their authors' biographies will be published in the conference booklet. All full-text papers accepted by the conference and their authors' biographies will be published in the conference proceedings with an ISBN.

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
